Basic Crime Scene

October 20 - 22, 2014 Cost: \$295

This course will orient you to locating, documenting, collecting, and/or processing physical evidence recovered from scenes

of crime. We will take you step-by-step through processing the scene beginning with the documentation of the event. Particular attention will be paid to the sequential processing of evidence for latent fingerprints. Items suitable for fingerprinting will be emphasized and you will participate in hands-on training with powders and demonstrations involving fingerprint development chemistry. The presumptive testing of suspected blood at the scene and fundamental documentation of bloodstain patterns will be covered, along with discussions regarding the enhancement of bloodstain patterns for further comparison and possible individualization.

We will also address the issue of alternate light sources for both the detection of trace evidence and luminescent fingerprints. This course will equip investigators and crime scene technicians with the knowledge and skills necessary to capture that all important fingerprint, footwear pattern, or DNA match, thus greatly enhancing the possibility of identifying the suspect. (Course length: 20 hours)

Basic Digital Photography for Law Enforcement Officers

October 22 - 24, 2014 Cost: \$295

This course is designed specifically for those who are currently active in digital photographic

documentation of crime scenes and all other forms of photography within the scope of law enforcement. We will guide you through the proper use of your department-issued digital camera as well as in the documentation of crime scenes and specific evidence. This will be accomplished through a series of lectures, demonstrations, and hands-on applications.

You will be required to photographically record mock evidence with your departmentally-issued camera throughout the training. The course requires full attendance of all scheduled instruction and completion of all planned projects. (Course length: 20 hours)

About the instructor: Donald Barker is in his 25th year of public safety service and training, having completed 10 years of service with the Pinellas County (Largo, Florida) Sheriff's Office, as a Crime Scene Unit Supervisor and more than 20 years as an adjunct and fulltime Forensic Sciences Training Specialist with IPTM. Mr. Barker's career traversed the era of light energy searches, DNA, and the transition from film to digital, while working as a CSI. He has trained more than 10,000 personnel in crime scene investigative courses with IPTM since 1995, completing more than 100 digital photography courses and assisting nearly 2000 officers in the proficiency of digital photography.
